Georgia State University School of Public Health (GSU/SPH) is seeking a faculty member to join its Division of Health Management & Policy (HMP). Health management and policy is concerned with the administration and conceptual framework of public health and health service delivery, including the interface between population health and accountable care organizations, not-for-profit, and community-based health care organizations, formulating and implementing health care policy, analyzing the distribution of and access to health care services, identifying disparity in the ability to access health care information and services, financing and reimbursement of health care services, and evaluating quality and outcomes of health care services and programs. The HMP educational track draws upon a variety of disciplines, including medicine, health administration, health policy, public administration, business, public health law, health ethics, and economics.

**Responsibilities:** GSU/SPH is seeking a Clinical Professor to join a dynamic interdisciplinary team of faculty and staff who are working to provide students with the ability to solve healthcare problems in practical ways by understanding the distinct viewpoints of those who receive, provide, finance and regulate public health and healthcare policy. Responsibilities will include a mix of teaching and/or research including mentoring students, and building partnerships with organizations internal and external to the Georgia State University.

**Qualifications:** Candidates must have an earned doctorate in Medicine, Public Health, Public Administration, or a related field with a focus on the healthcare delivery system, the political processes involved in formulating and implementing health policy, the interface between public health and healthcare delivery, the dissemination of evidence-based public health practices, public health program administration and/or delivery, identifying and addressing health disparity, and related areas. Candidates must demonstrate experience in actively contributing to medicine, public health practice, teaching, and/or leadership in program administration. Candidates should be able to demonstrate a track record of building partnerships with public health partners, accountable care organizations or knowledge of how to incorporate policy, public health surveillance, and intervention methods into these systems.
